PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

The engineer assists in the company sales and profit effort by effectively estimating and designing metal building systems. The engineer is expected to have good communication skills for project coordination with customers and field sales. With experience, proper understanding of engineering impacts on other work groups such as detailing, production and customers are mandatory.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Formal education required is a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from an ABET accredited institution with a focus in structural engineering. Registration as a professional engineer is not required for entry position, but is expected over time. School or work experience with structural steel design, and working knowledge with AISC and AISI is preferred. Direct work experience within the pre-engineered building industry is a benefit. Effective verbal and written skills with the English language are required. Proficient use of hand held scientific calculators, computer terminal keyboard (and mouse), and document reproduction machines are necessary. Also, work includes manual numeric calculations and hand drawing of sketches to represent building design components. Ability to travel to construction sites is needed on an infrequent basis. The typical work environment also includes spending some time in the production area for answering design questions and job training. Normal work does not require lifting more than 30 lb.
